Monday, Tuesday & Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

- Sites will be offering Pfizer Vaccine doses/boosters & Covid-19 PCR Testing.
- Moderna Vaccine available upon request.
- No appointments necessary.
- Dates and times are subject to change.

All Florida residents are now eligible to receive any COVID-19 vaccine as prescribed by the Food and Drug Administration. The Pfizer vaccine is authorized for persons 5 and up (all minors must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian).
