Reach Out and Read is a program that promotes early literacy and school readiness in pediatric exam rooms. During well-child and immunization visits at the Florida Department of Health in Lake County, children between the age of 6 months to 5 years and their parents, are provided information by trained doctors and nurses about the importance of reading aloud, singing and engaging in conversation with their young child. The child is given a new developmentally age appropriate books to the take home.
