Eustis, FL. – The Florida Department of Health in Lake County (DOH-Lake) COVID-19 Immunization sites revised schedule for the week of April 12th, 2021 till April 16, 2021:

St. Patrick Catholic Church Site located at 6803 Old Hwy 441, Mt. Dora.
Tuesday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
Open for 1st and 2nd doses on a first come, first served basis.
**Please note this will be the last day of operations at this site.*

DOH-Lake Community Health Site located at 560 W. DeSoto Street, Clermont.
Monday thru Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. ***scheduled 2nd dose appointments only***

DOH-Lake Umatilla Site located at 249 E. Collins Street, Umatilla.
Wednesday thru Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. ***scheduled 2nd dose appointments only***

Schedules are based on vaccine availability. Dates and times are subject to change.

As a reminder, the Lake Square Mall immunization site is available by appointment only. Residents may preregister for an appointment online at myvaccine.fl.gov or by phone at 866-201-6909 (or 833-476-1031 for TTY users).

All Florida residents are now eligible to receive any COVID-19 vaccine as prescribed by the Food and Drug Administration. The Pfizer vaccine is authorized for persons 16 and up (all minors must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian). The Moderna and Janssen (Johnson and Johnson) vaccines are authorized for persons age 18 and up.
